On behalf of the Organising Committee, we are very pleased to present the Proceedings of the 2002 Asian Conference on Computer Vision.

We received 189 papers from a wide community spanning academia and industry. Despite the time of year, reluctance to fly and the distance to Australia from most parts of the world, we were pleasantly surprised at the interest in the conference.

The papers were submitted in full length. Each paper was blind reviewed by a panel of experts, and, after an exacting review process, 152 papers were accepted.
